Day 1

Welcome to Mongolia

Pickup at airport and transfer to your hotel.

40-60 min depending on traffic



Ulaanbaatar, or UB in short as most of the locals call it, is the capital of Mongolia. UB originated as a nomadic camp and moved around more than 20 times before finally settling in its current location in 1778. Today UB is a sprawling modern metropolis and a fantastic place to explore before heading into the wilderness.

After settling in to your hotel there is an option for a short city tour visiting the main square and the National History Museum. As an alternative you can relax after your long flight at the hotel.

Day 2

Murun

After breakfast fly to Murun and towards the start of your upcoming Adventure.

Lunch at Murun Restaurant



1.5 hours flight from the Capital, we will arrive at Murun, which serves as the gateway to the north and the great northern Taiga Forests. After arrival we will enjoy a nice local lunch.

Once packed up in our 4WD vehicles we will head north towards our first pit stop, Ulaan Uul, which is about 6 hours from Murun. We can get a good nights sleep at a rustic guest house and relax a bit before moving on.

Day 3

Renchinlkhumbé

We continue our drive north towards Renchinlkhumbé.

Picnic lunch



Our last part of this stunning drive will take us around 6 hours and take us to rural Renchinlkhumbé. The drive is truly spectacular and at this point we will be far from the nearest paved road. We will cross through rivers, drive across deep lush valleys and see some amazing landscapes.

Renchinlkhumbé is a small town in the very north of Mongolia, right on the border of Russia and the great siberian forest.

Day 4-5

Darkhad Valley

It is now time to saddle up. Meet your horse companion which will accompany you the next couple of days.

Picnic Lunch



In the morning we will be presented to our wranglers who will follow us on our ride to our final destination in the region, the Tsaatan Reindeer Herders.

The Mongolian Horse is an incredibly sturdy steed and a smaller horse compared to the horses we are used to in the western world. They are easy to ride and very well mannered. We can choose our route and daily riding duration depending on the skill level and stamina of the riders in our group.

Day 6

Arrival at the Tsaatan

Around lunch time we will arrive at the Tsaatan Camp.

Picnic lunch



Teepees start emerging from the shadows as we ride through the dense forests and we know that we have arrived at the home of the Tsaatan. The Tsaatan has lived in this area for thousands of years and very few things have changed over time. The tribe is highly dependant on their reindeer, which are used for a variety of purposes such as tools, clothing, food and transportation.

Once we arrive we will setup camp and settle in for a journey back in time. We will learn about the daily life of the Tsaatan and be able to see how they work and live. We can opt to either stay in a traditional teepee or in modern tents.

Day 7

Tsaatan Camp

Spend the day learning about the daily life of the Tsaatan Reindeer Herders.

Picnic lunch



A nice relaxing day in the company of the Tsaatan tribe. We will have the opportunity to purchase crafts from the locals, explore the stunning surroundings and wind down in a way rarely experienced in the modern world.

We will prepare a picnic lunch and dinner. There will also be plenty of opportunity to try some of the local delicacies such as reindeer milk tea, curd and pastries.

Day 8

Tsagaannuur

Ride back out of the taiga forest towards Tsagaannuur.

Picnic lunch



After an incredible stay with the Tsaatan we ride out of the forest and prepare for the journey back to Murun.

As we leave the forests the landscapes change dramatically as we enter the great steppe once more. In the afternoon we arrive in Tsagaannur, a small village where we will stay for the night.

Day 9

Back to Murun

4WD back to Murun and a much needed chance to freshen up with a hot shower.

We embark after breakfast on a beautiful drive through valleys and great plains on our return journey to Murun. Along the way we will stop for lunch. Expect a full day of driving to reach our destination.

Day 10

Ulaanbaatar

We return to the capital for a day before heading out west to visit with the Eagle Hunters.

Lunch at local restaurant



After a 1.5 hour flight we return to Ulaanbaatar. Once checked in to our hotel for the night we will visit the Chinggis Khaan statue complex. The statue is the largest Chinggis Khaan statue in the world and quite the sight to behold. On the way back we can stop by an outlet for some Mongolian Cashmere shopping.

At night we will enjoy a nice dinner at a local restaurant.

Day 11

Bayan-Ölgii

After breakfast fly to Bayan-Ölgii province.

Lunch at homestay



After a 2 hour flight we arrive in the western most part of Mongolia right on the outskirts of the great Altai Mountain range. This is the land of the Kazakh and the where the Eagle Hunters roam. The Altai Mountains spread across Mongolia, China, Russia and Kazakhstan. It is an absolutely stunning area and something that will stick with you forever.

We will drive to meet our hosts for the next few days where we will live alongside the Eagle Hunter and his family.

Family Stay

2 full days staying with the Eagle Hunter and his family.

We will spend two full days alongside the family and learn about their daily life. We can embark on a hunting trip in the beautiful mountains and get up and close with the birds of prey in their natural environment.

Day 14-15

Ulaanbaatar

Head back to Ulaanbaatar for a couple of days in the city before heading back home to the US.

We will bid the family farewell and head back to Ulaanbaatar on a 2 hour flight.

Enjoy a couple of days to explore the busy capital. The shopping is excellent, the food is incredible and the markets are a must see.

The final night we will attend a folk concert and a final dinner with a bag full of memories that will last a lifetime.
